

How ISIS Describes its Government Structure



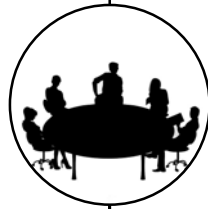
Khalifah

The Khalifah defends the homeland, fortifies the fronts, prepares the armies, implements the hudud (divine ordinances), enforces the people's adherence to Sharia rulings, and upholds and spreads the religion.



The Shura Council

The Shura Council assists the Khalifah in completing his duties.



The Delegated Committee

The committee supports the Khalifah in supervising the wilayat, the dawawin, and the committees and offices.



Wilayat in Iraq and Syria



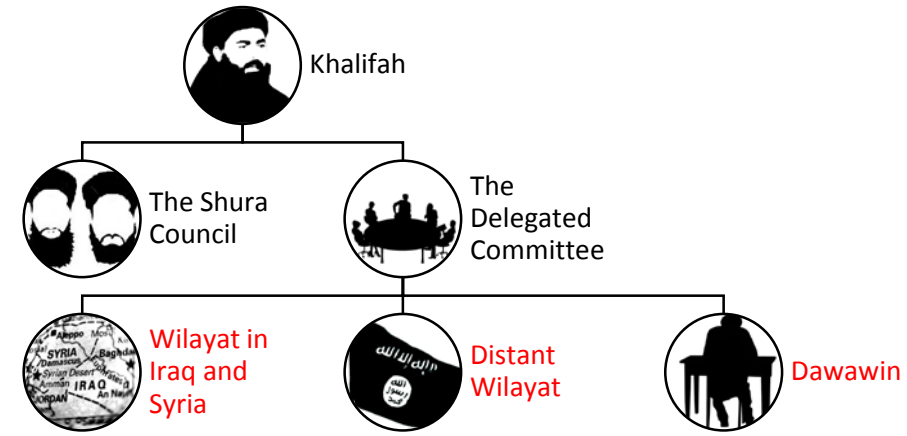
Distant Wilayat

Offices and Committees



This committee receives those who emigrate to the Islamic State, and they provide the various committees and dawawin with what they require.

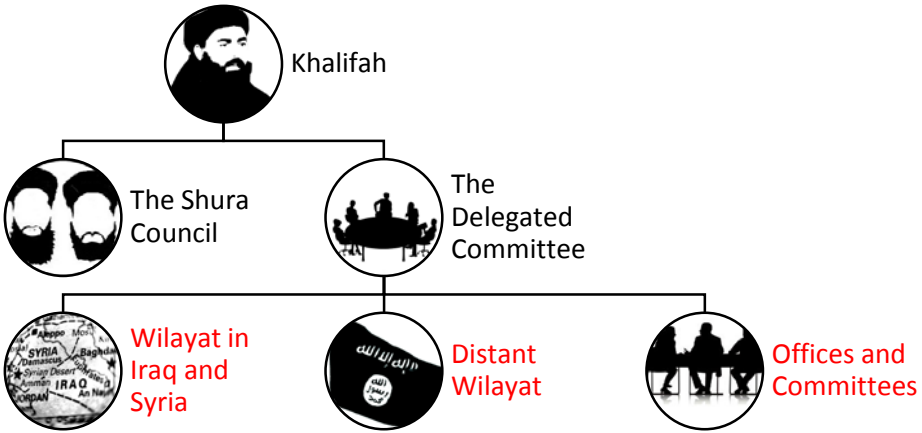
This committee is responsible for following up on Muslim captives, seeking to rescue them from captivity; it looks after the families of Shuhada' and cares for their children.

This office is concerned with investigating Shar'i issues and preparing research.

It is responsible for overseeing and directing affairs of wilayat outside of Iraq and Sham.

Dawawin



Diwan of Judgment and Grievances

A number of judges are responsible for clarifying and enforcing the Shar'i rulings in matters of blood, wealth, and family- and marriage-related issues.



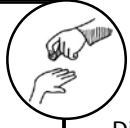
Diwan of Hisbah

This diwan responsible for ordering the public to perform good deeds and preventing them from committing evil deeds, holding them accountable to rulings based on the Shari'ah.



Diwan of Proselytizing and Mosques

This diwan is responsible for preparing and appointing imams and preachers, building and preparing masajid, and holding preparatory seminars and Shar'i courses.



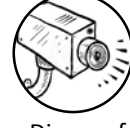
Diwan of Zakah

This diwan is responsible for collecting and distributing the zakah; additionally, it is concerned with meeting the needs of the poor and destitute.



Diwan of Media

It is the body responsible for any content released by the Islamic State, whether that content is audio, visual, or written.



Diwan of Public Security

This diwan is responsible for safeguarding internal public security in the Islamic State, protecting it from anything that would disrupt it, and waging war against infiltration and against any spy networks.



Diwan of Services

It is a diwan responsible for supplying water and electricity, paving and maintaining roads, and supervising and maintaining the public utilities in the Islamic State.



Diwan of Soldiery

Responsibilities: management of wars, guarding the frontlines, planning and preparing for military raids, dispatching divisions, brigades, and battalions, and providing the Khilafah with trained personnel for his army.



Diwan of Education

It is responsible for propelling the wheel of knowledge. It regulates curriculums and courses as well as locates the required personnel.



Diwan of Health

This diwan is responsible for developing the health sector, preventing and treating sickness and disease, and provides medical needs.



Diwan of Agriculture

This diwan is responsible for agricultural and animal resources and maintaining food security for Islamic State residents.



Diwan of Resources (Rikaz)

The entity is responsible for the exploitation of oil, gas, and mineral resources.



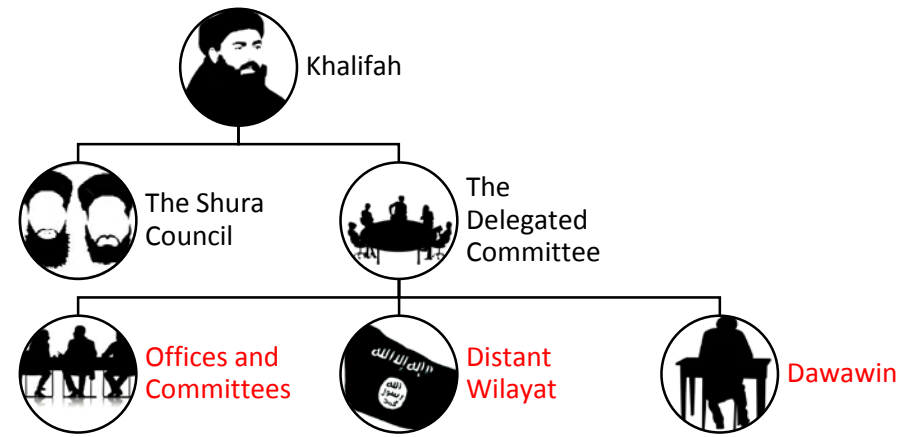
Diwan of Treasury

This diwan is responsible for protecting and managing the Islamic State's wealth.

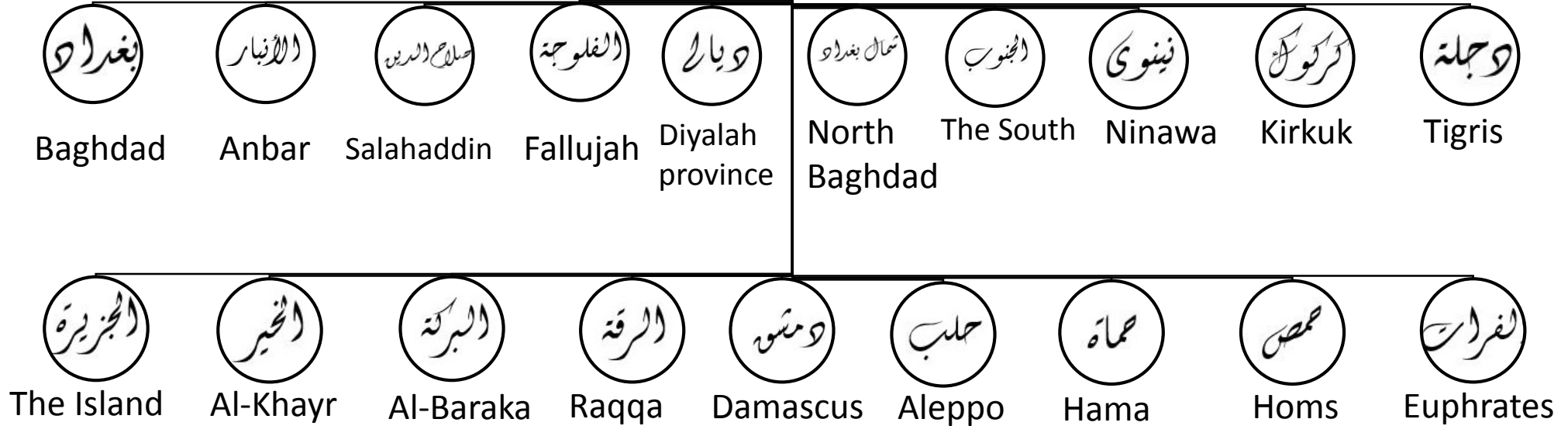


Diwan of Fay' and Ghana'im

It is a diwan responsible for counting and safekeeping the wealth bestowed upon the state, following battles, raids, etc.; the diwan conducts the allocation of shares to those who deserve them.
